



- Your College Panhellenic votes to invite an NPC Consulting Team to your campus.
- A letter is sent to the NPC Area Advisor indicating the approval of the College Panhellenic and the Panhellenic advisor for the process to begin.
- The NPC Area Advisor forwards the request to the chairman of the NPC College Panhellenics Committee.

Annual Report Is Due April 15

Your College Panhellenic annual report, which you can find at www.npcwomen.org, is due **April 15**. Information from this report is compiled for the NPC annual report. The College Panhellenics Committee also uses this report to assess the needs of your Panhellenic and develop programs to assist you.

Please remember to contact your NPC Area Advisor when you are considering extension, recruitment changes in rules or style, changes to your Panhellenic bylaws or setting campus total. Chapter delegates should also remember to contact their national organization for assistance.

Accurate Rosters Are Vital

Accurate chapter rosters are vital to the success of your College Panhellenic. Chapter rosters for continuous open bidding purposes must be in accordance with the NPC resolutions regarding vacancies in total chapter size. Please review MR-14 in the Manual of Information about vacancies in total chapter size. **If chapters are above chapter total, they may not offer continuous open bids.** Please contact your NPC Area Advisor with questions.

Selecting, Training Recruitment Counselors?

Please refer to the NPC Recruitment Counselor Handbook when selecting and training recruitment counselors. This handbook was mailed to each College Panhellenic last fall. Additional copies are available on the NPC Web site.

Plan for Fall Formal Recruitment Now

If your campus holds fully structured recruitment in the fall, you should also be using the Release Figure Method. Now is the time to educate chapter membership recruitment chairmen and advisors on the RFM. This training should include information about flex lists and computerized recruitment systems. Flex lists are a great way to assist in maximizing opportunities for chapters and potential new members. To find out more, contact your NPC Area Advisor.
